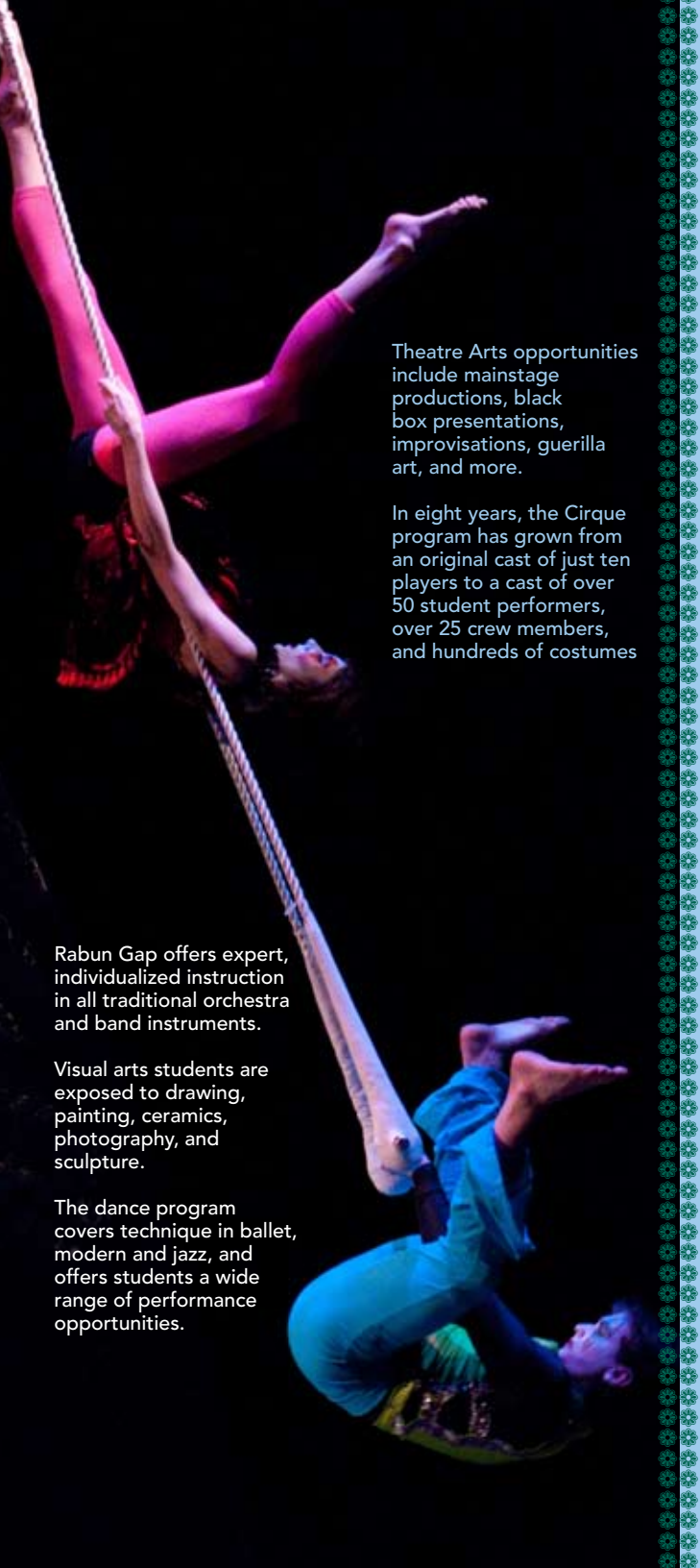

### MAD ABOUT THE ARTS

MAD Fest is our yearly celebration of the arts where students showcase their talents to the school and surrounding community. MAD is: Music, including chorus and band; Art, encompassing visual and industrial; and Drama, featuring dance and performance art.

### HIGHLY ACCLAIMED CIRQUE

Inspired by the famous Cirque du Soleil of Quebec, Rabun Gap's highly acclaimed Cirque program pushes the limits of traditional high school theater. Our Cirque artists have become proficient in a wide range of circus arts skills — from swinging trapeze, aerial silks and Chinese poles, to tumbling, clowning, and contortion.

### WELL-CRAFTED INDUSTRIAL ARTS

Our Industrial Arts and Technology program exposes students to metalworking, woodworking, and engineering drawing technology. Working inside our AutoCAD lab and fully equipped craft shop, students create projects ranging from handmade furniture, to metal sculpture, to the building of an electric trolley car.
